In the 1790s Joseph Haydn travelled from Austria to spend time in England and was inspired by the large-scale oratorio works of the venerable composer Handel. *The Creation*, considered Haydn's masterpiece, is based on the Book of Genesis and Milton's *Paradise Lost*. The Whitehall Choir, one of London's finest amateur choirs, is joined by the London Baroque Sinfonia, whose members are some of the best players of period instruments in the UK. The combination of orchestra, choir and superb soloists – Miriam Allan (soprano), Greg Tassell (tenor) and James Oldfield (bass) with Whitehall Choir's prize-winning accompanist Ian Tindale on continuo – will make for a wonderful evening of thrilling choruses and beautiful solo arias. Not to mention the tiger, horse, sheep and worm...

The Whitehall Choir, under its dynamic Music Director Joanna Tomlinson, is one of London's leading amateur choirs. The choir is always looking for talented singers (particularly tenors!). In demand as a workshop leader, Joanna's recent engagements include UK Choir Festival, ABCD, London Choral Conducting Masterclasses, and the Gabrieli Consort 'Roar' and Philharmonia Orchestra education schemes.
